

MEET THE DOLPHINS TANGALOOMA'S FAMILY TREE



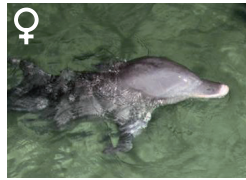
TANGALOOMA ISLAND RESORT

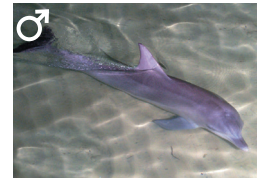

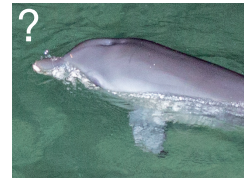
